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MICROCHIP IMPLANTATION

The microchip ID number is the horse's/pony's unique identifier throughout her/his life and becomes permanently integrated in our database. If microchipping is carried out as part of the registration process, the ID will also be printed on the animal's Certificate of Registration. For horses/ponies already registered, the microchip ID will be added to the animal's database information.

Microchip information is forwarded to the USEF, and all microchipped animals are automatically registered for their lifetime in the Equine Protection Registry EPR, as a safeguard in the case of loss, theft, or natural disasters.

The microchip should be implanted into the nuchal ligament on the left side of the neck at an approx. 15-degree angle, not subcutaneously. This procedure should be performed by a veterinarian. Because of the size of the needle by which the microchip is implanted, it is advisable to apply local anesthesia in the affected area.
